

MANUEL ANTONIO TOURS

Located on the Central Pacific coast of Costa Rica, Manuel Antonio remains one of the country's best beach and rainforest locations. <u>Manuel Antonio National Park</u> is the main attraction of the region, with monkeys, tropical birds, and iguanas comprising a large portion of the wildlife population. From almost every vantage point, rainforest vistas tumble into picture-perfect inlets and coves that punctuate the shoreline.

Area activities include canopy zip-lining, kayaking through mangrove estuaries, catamaran cruises, rafting, horseback riding, sea kayaking, hiking, and birding.

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Manuel Antonio National Park Hike (Closed on

Mondays)

Known as the country's favorite national park, Manuel Antonio features three beautiful beaches bordered by coastal rainforest, with nature trails abundant in wildlife. The animal life is diverse, with some 109-known species of mammals and 184 species of birds. Bring a bathing suit and towel to enjoy the beaches after the tour.

Damas Island Estuary Boat Tour

Explore one of Costa Rica's most unique environments from the comfort of a boat! As you glide through the Damas Island Mangrove Estuary, you might spot curious families of monkeys as they migrate across the mangrove ecosystem in search of food and adventure. You might also see tropical seabirds, turtles, a range of reptiles, and maybe even a caiman or two! You will wind through acres of pristine Costa Rican estuary as guides explain why the mangrove eco-structure so vital to Costa Rica and the world. This tour will end with a relaxing yet rewarding meal.

Canopy Safari Zip-line

Your adventure begins with a drive through the rainforest. On the drive you will stop and learn about the flora and fauna of the area. Enjoy a hearty meal at a ranch house before gearing up and starting your canopy adventure! Traverse 18 platforms, 10 cables, 2 rappel lines, a suspension bridge, and a Tarzan swing. You're sure to get an incredible adrenaline rush while zipping from platform to platform across the rainforest canopy!

Your morning on the river is followed by a tasty lunch before you transfer back to your hotel.

Damas Island Mangrove by Kayak

Paddle gently through the inland waterways of the Damas Island Estuary, one of the most unique eco-systems on the planet. This important ecological area is where the salt waters of the ocean meet the fresh waters of tropical rivers, creating a periodically submerged forest of hanging roots. On the banks, you might spot local inhabitants, like the Sally light foot crab, boa constrictors, silky anteaters, monkeys, lizards, seabirds, and sometimes even crocodiles!

Coastal Sea Kayaking

Paddle your way around the Manuel Antonio coastline on this active kayaking tour. Beginning at the port of Quepos, you will start your adventure by paddling south. From a vantage point only possible in kayaks, you'll catch awe-inspiring glimpses of Manuel Antonio's breathtaking cliffs as we follow along the coastline. Depending on the tide, you may stop off for a snack at a secluded beach. Then, paddle close to tropical rock formations, where shorebirds are known to nest. This fun half-day on the water is a great way to explore the area and get moving!

Rainmaker Reserve Hike

Located about 30 minutes from Manuel Antonio, this private rainforest reserve is a great place to experience local wildlife, like birds, butterflies, frogs, and lizards. Explore the Rainmaker trails with your guide, who will teach you about the history and biodiversity of the reserve and its inhabitants. After this, you'll have a chance to navigate the canopy bridge system and experience the rainforest from an elevated perspective.

Nocturnal Jungle Walk

This unique guided adventure is 2 hours to be a part of one of the most fascinating ecosystems in the country – the nocturnal tropical wet forest. Get in contact with many of the nocturnal inhabitants of the Wildlife Refuge, such as the kinkajou, the armadillo, or various snakes! With more than 30 identified snake species, you'll learn about which are dangerous and about their natural history. You'll also have the chance to visit the Tropical Aquatic Gardens, which is home to a variety of frog and toad species.

Santa Juana Mountain Tour

Experience the magic of nature and enjoy a unique part of Costa Rican rural heritage! This expedition takes 45 minutes inland to the lush, jungle-shrouded slopes of the Fila Chonta Mountains. See the mountain streams that feed rivers on their journey to the Pacific Ocean and enjoy a refreshing swim beneath mesmerizing waterfalls. You'll also see fascinating regional wildlife, including a myriad of birds, insects and reptiles. Try your luck at organic Tilapia fishing, visit an authentic sugar mill powered by two massive oxen. Visit the rustic Santa Juana pueblo, where you'll learn about coffee and citrus production, participate in the Carbon Offset Tree Planting Adoption Program, and enjoy lunch while taking in the vista of the coastline of Manuel Antonio National Park.

Santa Juana Bird Watching

The private nature reserve at Santa Juana is a must for birdwatchers! 150 bird species native to Central and South Pacific Costa Rica can be found within it such as white hawks, graynecked wood rails, southern lapwings, purple gallinules, fierybilled aracaris, swallow-tailed kites, wood storks, and pale-billed woodpeckers. A number of wading species like the Bare-throated Tiger Heron, the Roseate Spoonbill, and the White Ibis live nearby. The primary forest's populations of White hawk, Redcapped Manaking, and Baird's Trogon are both fascinating and lovely. At the end of the tour, cool off in a spectacular natural swimming pool.

Villa Vanilla Spice Tour

Manuel Antonio's Villa Vanilla tropical spice plantation sits on 125 acres of primary and secondary rainforest. Certified organic and biodynamic, Villa Vanilla is home to a variety of spices and plants, including cocoa, ceylon cinnamon, and of course, vanilla. This tour involves a gentle walk through the plantation, along a unique garden trail. At the Punta Mira Viewpoint, you'll experience the "Flavors of the World" tasting menu – an assortment of gourmet chocolate, vanilla and Ceylon cinnamon treats, among other spices and seasonal tropical fruits. This tour is a unique "foodie" experience with a major focus on sustainability.

You will end your trip learning about the private herb and plant garden as they help educate locals and visitors alike on how to preserve the indigenous plant and herb varieties of their beautiful country.
