

# SOUTH PACIFIC TOURS

The stretch of South Pacific Costa Rica coastline from Dominical to Ojochal, known as the Costa Ballena, is Costa Rica's up-and-coming beach and rainforest destination. The South Pacific Coast is more remote than other areas of the country, sitting just north of the Osa Peninsula. Pristine rainforest, miles of ocean views, and solitude are some of the South Pacific's most magnificent features.

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# **Corcovado National Park Full Day Tour**

Early this morning, board a boat at Punta Uvita beach for a 1.5hour journey to Corcovado National Park. Along the way, you might spot whales (when in season), dolphins, and more. Upon arrival at the park, you'll embark on two guided hikes along two different trails. The first hike takes around 3 hours and the second hike about 1.5 hours. Keep an eye out for spider, howler, and white-faced monkeys, sloths, coatis, tapirs, and a variety of birds, plants, and trees. At the end of the second trail visit a small waterfall to cool off.

\*Not suitable for pregnant women due to potential conditions during the boat ride.

#### **Cano Island Snorkeling Tour**

Early this morning, transfer by ground to Uvita beach. Here you will board a boat for a 1.5 - 2-hour journey to Cano Island, about 30 miles off the coast. The island is surrounded by five platforms of low coral reef, home to parrotfish, Crocodile Needlefish, Puffer, Cornet fish, and schools of Jack Fish. You might also spot sea turtles, stingrays, morays, and white tip sharks. You will snorkel for about 2 hours in two different locations in front of the Island. After the tour you will have a picnic lunch on a beautiful beach on Violines Island, surrounded by lush vegetation (only if ocean conditions are normal - if not you will return to the coast and set up the lunch on Uvita beach).

#### Marino Ballena National Park Sea Kayak &

#### Snorkel

This tour begins at low tide as the waves shift to one side of the Whale's Tail, which is a good spot for snorkeling. Paddling to this point will take between 30 to 45 minutes. The snorkeling portion of the tour will take between 45 minutes and 1.5 hours and will give you the opportunity to see a variety of fish and coral species, such as Giant Conch, starfish, Parrotfish Snapper, Damsels, eels, Moorish Idol, Surgeons and various types of coral species. Catch a wave and ride back into shore on your kayak. Then, enter a small mangrove forest in Ballena Marine Park where it is possible to spot sea birds, toucans, and some small reptiles.

### **Terraba-Sierpe National Wetlands Tour by Boat**

Terraba-Sierpe National Wetlands is an internationally recognized RAMSAR wetland site and includes the estuary of the Térraba and Sierpe rivers. It is one of the largest mangrove wetlands in Central America and serves as an important habitat for many species of birds, fish, mammals, and reptiles. This boat tour departs from one of the arms of the Térraba and enters the complex mangrove wetlands, giving visitors an intimate experience with some of mother nature's most interesting flora and fauna. Your guide will explain the role of every component in the ecosystem and search for wildlife throughout the channels of the Terraba River.

# **Snorkeling at Marino Ballena National Park**

The Ballena Marine National Park is a snorkeling location with coral reefs and incredible fish diversity. Depart from Punta Uvita Beach and visit the great snorkeling treasures of the Marino Ballena National Park: reefs of Ballena Island, Tres Hermanas Islets, and the Punta Uvita or "Whale's Tail." You can find parrotfish, butterflyfish, blue surgeonfish, and a great number of starfish at a depth that ranges from 1 to 3 meters. Your guide will spend an hour at each reef searching for and directing you toward the marine life, and then provide an explanation of what you saw when you are back on the boat.

## Whale & Dolphin Combo Tour (seasonal)

Board a boat from Punta Uvita Beach and visit the famous Punta Uvita Whale's Tail, Ballena Island, Tres Hermanas Islets, and Ventana Sea Caves. During the tour, you will search for Humpback Whales (seasonally) and two different species of resident dolphins. The boat will pass near the caverns of Ventanas Beach where you can observe wonderful rocky formations and the amazing caverns that were carved out by the ocean over thousands of years. \*\*Tours during the dry season (January – Feb) include a short session of snorkeling on the reefs of the Marino Ballena National Park

\*Whale migration season: mid-July - October & mid-December – February

The waters off the South Pacific coast of Costa Rica are rich in nutrients, and there is a great variety of mackerel, wahoo, mahi-mahi, yellowfin tuna, black tuna, & snapper. The offshore fishing is done within 20 miles of the shore in deep water.

This tour also includes 2 hours of snorkeling at Cano Island as an optional activity. The island is surrounded by five platforms of low coral reefs with many coral species. The coral reef environments are home to many different species of fish and other aquatic animals.
